



Dear Coaches,

Ex - Fremont High School wrestling coach Webber Lawson passed away on November 19, 2009. Coach Lawson became a household name at FHS when he turned around the FHS Wrestling program in the 1960s. In his first year he led the team to the first ever CCS team title, the team had placed last in the league the prior year. This success continued as FHS won the first 3 CCS team titles and finished in the top two for the first five years of the tournament. FHS Wrestler also won a Northern CA title during that span. Coach Lawson went on to be hugely influential in the conception of the CA State Tournament. In order to recognize over 25 years in service to the wrestling community and his unbelievable amount of influence on creating a tradition of tough, college focused, wrestling here at Fremont we created this tournament and a scholarship fund in 2010. We are honored to hold a tournament in Coach Lawson's honor.

You are cordially invited to compete in the Webber Lawson Memorial Tournaments. We hope to continue to improve the quality of these tournaments to help ensure that they epitomize the tough wrestling that Coach Lawson was known for. 

TRACKWRESTLING

This tournament will be run on trackwrestling and we will use the OPC contacts to contact coaches. Please be sure to update your OPC contacts at the beginning of the season. You don't have to put your AD as an OPC contact.

COST

JV/2nd Man (Co-Ed)

\$300 for a team (14 wrestlers, 1 per weight class)
\$25 per wrestler

Boys Varsity

\$350 per team (14 wrestlers, 1 per weight class)
\$30 per wrestler

Girls Varsity

\$250 per team (14 wrestlers, 1 per weight class)
\$20 per wrestler

Tournament Structure Bracketing:

For all 3 Tournaments - brackets will be determined by the number of athletes in the weight class. Max number of wrestlers in a bracket will be 32. For all brackets sized between 17-32 wrestlers we will be using a 32 Man Cons. Format 3 Place 8 bracket. This means the first and second round losers in the Championship side will fall into a Cons bracket. For 12-16 wrestlers we will use a 16 Man Cons. WB 3rd Place 8 bracket. For 11 or less we will use a 8 Man WB 3rd bracket. For 6 or less we will use round robin brackets. The goal will be to maximize matches without extending operational time of the tournament.

Mats:

We will start Friday (Girls Varsity) on 6 mats and expand to 8 as quickly as possible with school getting out (dependent on PE's need for small gym based on weather). We will run 8 until the final round of Friday, which will end with a 3 mat final. We will run 7 to 10 mats on Saturday adding two mats to the cafeteria if necessary based on the size of the tournament. We will again run a 3 mat final. For the JV/2nd Man Tournament we will run 8 mats straight through until we cut down to 6 for the final.

All of this information is tentative and subject to change prior to the tournament. We will post the most updated information on the Wrestling.Life website.



We will be running paperless bouts with a projector displaying the mat assignments in the lobby of the main gym and in the small gym. Each day of wrestling will be setup as a separate event on trackwrestling.

Seeding and Lineups

We are lucky enough to have the State Ranker Michael Cho seed our tournament. Lineups will be due on Wednesday December 7th at 9 PM. Seeding matters for this tournament due to the one day format. Identifying and separating the top 8 wrestlers in each weight will be the goal. This early in the season seeding is very difficult.
